Or, ask someone to air write the letters you tell them to spell your word.

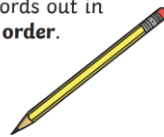


Spelling Challenge

- Repeat this three times, trying to improve your fluency and expression each time. Remember to use the punctuation to help you and show you where you should pause.
