Write your words **in the air** with your finger. Ask someone to read your words as you write. Or, ask someone to air write the letters you tell them to spell your word.

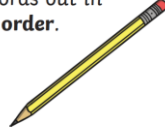

**Reading** - If your child has a reading record, please encourage them to read with you daily for about 10 minutes. Please record a quick comment in the record book.

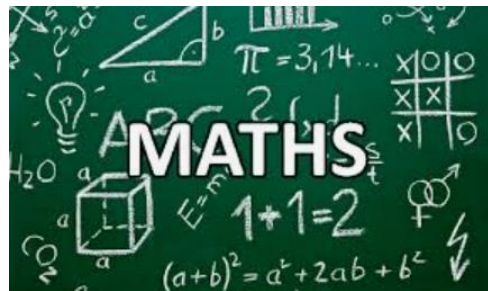
If your child has a reading diary, please still encourage them to read aloud with you and to complete a review once a week, using the questions at the front of the reading diary to help them.
