26. Writing Race

time.

27. Code Words

Come up with a code for each letter of the alphabet and then write each word in code.
e.g. a = b = ♦ c = ♣

28 Word Classes

Sort your spelling words into word classes - nouns, verbs, adjectives etc.
Be careful - some words can be used in more than one category e.g. swimming.



TT Rockstars - Please look inside the cover of your child's homework book to find their log in for TT Rockstars, in order that they can practise their times tables, which are particularly important for year 4 this year.

Year 4 children need to be practising as often as they can.
