Other Handed</b></p> <p>Write each word 5 times, switching the hand you write it with each time. Say the word as you spell it.</p> | <p><b>4. Vowel Spotlight</b></p> <p>Write your words using one colour for the vowels and another colour for the consonants.<br/><b>(vowels: a, e, i, o, u)</b></p> |
