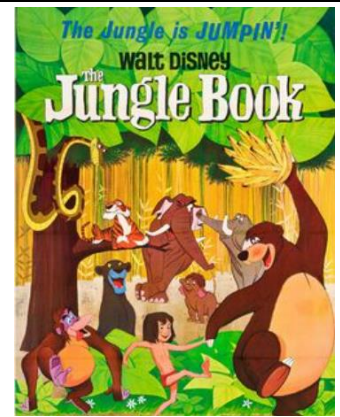
Year 3 - Maths - Money (If you have taken a paper copy and cannot see the coins clearly enough, please look at the colour copy on our class page on the website)
