Please practise your weekly spellings in any way you would like to. Here are some ideas to help you this week;

<p>1. ABC Order</p> <p>Write all of your spelling words in alphabetical (ABC) order.</p>	<p>2. Word Parts</p> <p>Write your words. Then use a coloured pencil to divide the words into syllables. e.g. jumping caterpillar</p>	<p>3. Other Handed</p> <p>Write each word 5 times, switching the hand you write it with each time. Say the word as you spell it.</p>	<p>4. Vowel Spotlight</p> <p>Write your words using one colour for the vowels and another colour for the consonants. (vowels: a, e, i, o, u)</p>
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TT Rockstars - The children will shortly be given their log ins for TT Rockstars, which will then be stuck inside the cover of your child's homework book. This is a great way for them to practise their times tables, which are particularly important for both year 3 and 4 this year.

Year 3 and 4; At the moment we are learning our **10x and 2x** table- both multiplication and division facts.

Reading - If your child has a reading record, please encourage them to read with you daily for about 10 minutes. Please record a quick comment in the record book.

If your child is a 'free' reader, please still encourage them to read aloud with you to continue practising their fluency, prosody and comprehension.

All children need to have their reading book and record (if they have one) with them every day in school.
