If your child is a 'free' reader, please still encourage them to read aloud with you to continue practising their fluency, prosody and comprehension.

All children need to have their reading book and record (if they have one) with them every day in school.

Year 4; words where 'i' makes an 'ee' sound (y changing to an i)
