Prefixes and Suffixes</b></p> <p>Underline the prefixes and suffixes in the words you are learning. Make sure you know what they mean. e.g. <u>im</u>portant happ<u>ness</u></p>	<p><b>12. Word Search</b></p> <p>Create your own word search with your spellings. Show the answers to your puzzle in a different colour.</p>
