Picture &amp; a Story</b></p> <p>Draw a picture defining each word. Write a sentence about your picture using the word.</p>	<p><b>15. Words without Vowels</b></p> <p>Write all of your words replacing vowels with a line. Go back and see if you can fill in the vowels. e.g. q--st--n = question</p>	<p><b>16. Train Words</b></p> <p>Write the entire list end-to-end as one long word. Write each new word in a different colour. e.g. <b>trainbackstop</b></p>
