Words Within Words</p> <p>Write each spelling word and then write at least 2 words made from that word. e.g. catch - cat, hat</p>	<p>20. Picture words</p> <p>Draw a picture and hide your spelling words in the picture.</p>

This is a great way for them to practise their times tables, which are particularly important for both year 3 and 4 this year.

If your child is a 'free' reader, please still encourage them to read aloud with you to continue practising their fluency, prosody and comprehension.

All children need to have their reading book and record (if they have one) with them every day in school.
